Stella's Story:

Stella's story with MaineHealth Barbara Bush Children's (MHBBC) began before birth. A few weeks before her due date, her parents learned they were both carriers of the genetic mutation for cystic fibrosis (CF), a condition that affects the lungs and digestive system. This explained why Stella was experiencing a bowel blockage in the womb.

To ensure the best care, her family transferred to MHBBC, where specialists prepared for her delivery and possible complications. After Stella was born, doctors confirmed her diagnosis of CF.

She spent 10 days in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), receiving IV medications, tests, and treatments while her parents learned how to manage her condition.

Against the odds, Stella cleared her blockage without surgery — a rare outcome for CF patients.

Since leaving the NICU, Stella has received ongoing care through the MaineHealth Pediatric Specialty Care Cystic Fibrosis Clinic and, remarkably, has never required hospitalization. Her parents credit this to the exceptional care they've received from the CF team, who have supported them since day one.
