

Urology “Bedside Stent” Protocol

Pre-procedure Checklist

- Assessed in person by the urology service
- Option discussed with patient/family and he/she/they are amenable to a bedside procedure
- Attending to attending discussion about the plan.
 - Confirm no need for procedural sedation.
 - Confirm no need for ER nursing/staff support
- No abnormal anatomy or concerns about the feasibility
- Patient does not meet sepsis criteria (if +sepsis and there is no OR availability, there should be a discussion about moving to the ICU or trauma bay for optimal post procedure monitoring)

Procedure

- Formal time out
- Side marked
- Attending present
- Peri procedure antibiotics given prior to the procedure.

Post-procedure

- KUB to confirm stent placement
- Observation period/time frame confirmed by urology, patient and ER
 - Time frame and vital sign monitoring depends on the clinical situation and should be agreed on by the providers.
 - If expected post procedure observation period is over 4 hours, urology will admit the patient to their service

"Implant" added within Epic (urology only)

- Phone encounter with follow up plan in chart if patient is being discharged.
