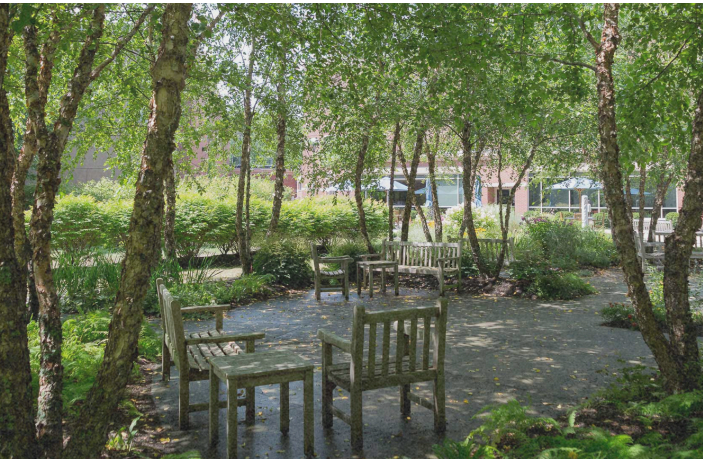

Applications are only accepted through PhORCAS application portal. **Application Deadline is January 9, 2026.**

The following materials should be submitted:

- Letter of intent
- Curriculum vitae (CV)
- Transcript
- Three (3) references

PGY1 Residents shall be graduates of an ACPE accredited Doctor of Pharmacy program or equivalence certificate and be eligible for Maine Pharmacist licensure.
