

ORBITAL FRACTURE PROTOCOL

CRITERIA FOR INPATIENT CONSULT FOR ORBITAL FRACTURE

1. <12 YEARS OLD
2. CONCERN FOR GLOBE TRAUMA ON IMAGING
3. PATIENT REPORTS *SIGNIFICANT* DECREASE IN VISION FROM BASELINE (UNABLE TO COUNT FINGERS AT 1-2 FEET)
4. DOUBLE VISION IN PRIMARY GAZE (LOOKING STRAIGHT)
5. NEW FLASHES/FLOATERS
6. LARGE/BULLOUS SUBCONJUNCTIVAL HEMORRHAGE IN A PATIENT THAT IS UNABLE TO REPORT VISION CHANGES (EX. INTUBATED PATIENT)

CRITERIA FOR URGENT REPAIR (ADULTS – can wait for AM ophtho consult)

1. EOM RESTRICTION > OR = 50% WILL REQUIRE FORCED DUCTIONS – IF RESTRICTED NEEDS REPAIR WITHIN 72 HOURS
2. HUGE DEFECT CAUSING ENOPHTHALMOS/DEFORMITY WITHIN 7-9 DAYS
