There are specific rights that apply to you if you are hospitalized at Spring Harbor Hospital.

These include the right to:

- be treated with dignity and respect;
- be free from abuse and neglect;
- be safe and comfortable;
- access adequate medical care;
- access outdoor activities;
- give or withhold consent to treatment;
- be involved in your treatment and discharge planning;
- be free from unnecessary restraint and seclusion; and,
- receive visitors, send and receive mail, and have private phone conversations.

- Involuntary commitment
- Emergency Department issues
- Access to community-based mental health services
- Concerns regarding your guardian and/or payee (if applicable)
- Housing issues/Eviction
