


Overview of Projects

This year* we are focusing on upgrading outdoor spaces that enhance the patient, visitor and care team member experience. The healing power of nature is well documented. What we see every day impacts how we feel. With patient privacy and healing in mind, we will be creating or revitalizing outdoor spaces for everyone to enjoy.

WCGH

At WCGH a healing garden will be created for patients, visitors and care team members. The garden will provide a peaceful vista for patients receiving infusion and chemotherapy treatments, among many other departments, while also providing privacy. Intentionally designed to be viewed from within the hospital, and also from the sidewalk, the garden will feature a rock wall sourced from local quarries and will include hidden vignettes that can be explored and enjoyed while providing visual separation. The plantings will be chosen with care to provide visual appeal throughout the seasons.





PBMC

At PBMC the interior courtyards will be revitalized so they can be enjoyed by patients, visitors and care team members. This project will dramatically transform these highly visible gardens which can be viewed from many departments, including the SCU patient rooms, the hallway to day surgery and the lab waiting room. Oneway film will be added to the windows of patient rooms for optimal visual connection to the natural world from the inside out, while ensuring patient privacy. Established plantings will be complemented by thoughtful landscape features that will be appealing throughout the seasons.
