HIGH RISK

SUGGESTED EMERGENT CONSULTATION

SYMPTOMS AND LABS

Hyperthyroidism affecting pregnancy

Abnormal TSH, elevated T4

Elevated heart rate, tremors, palpitations

Hypothyroidism affecting pregnancy

TSH greater than 2.50 fatigue

Thyroid mass difficulty with swallowing

Abnormal thyroid U/S

Thyroid nodules

MODERATE RISK

SUGGESTED CONSULTATION OR CO-MANAGEMENT

SYMPTOMS AND LABS

Fatigue

Tremors

Hair loss

Palpitations

Weight gain

Labs: TSH,Total T₃ and T₄, Free T₄, TPO, TBG

LOW RISK

SUGGESTED ROUTINE CARE

SYMPTOMS AND LABS

Fatigue

Hair loss

Weight gain with abnormal TSH result

Labs: TSH, Total T₃, Total T₄, F Free T₄

SUGGESTED PREVISIT WORKUP

Call MMP REI and speak to Dr. Spratt's MA regarding urgent referrals

Labs: TSH, Free T4, Total T4 Total T3, TPO, TBG,

Thyroglobulin

U/S Thyroid

SUGGESTED WORKUP

Repeat: TSH, Free T4, Total T4 Total T3

Follow up thyroid labs in 6 weeks if medication prescribed

SUGGESTED MANAGEMENT

Follow up labs if needed
