Weekly Construction Activities, week of 1/13/2020

Congress Street Enabling:

• Bridge from the medical office building at 887 Congress Street will remain open; however, the access to 22 Bramhall will change on Jan. 14. Instead of accessing 22 Bramhall through the Gilman Garage, colleagues will take a left, and access through the Visitors Garage. The way will be clearly marked, and access to the route will be badge-controlled.

Scarborough Medical Office:

- Campus Drive between 96 and 84 will be closed on January 14 & 15 and January 21 & 22 in order to trench and install underground utilities. There will be temporary wayfinding signage installed directing traffic to Rte. 1 and around to the back of 81 Campus Dr.
- Blasting activities continue from four to eight times per day. Times will be: 9, 9:05, 11 and 11:05 a.m.; 1, 1:05, 3 and 3:05 p.m.
- Concrete contractor mobilizing.

St. John Street Garage:

- The central stairwell by the elevator banks will be closed Monday, Jan. 13, for lighting adjustments starting at 8 a.m.
- Work to install the street traffic signal system will begin at 9 a.m. on Monday, Jan. 20. Flaggers will direct traffic at the main entrance.
